Scoring

Scoring will consist of professional achievements, growth in career path, impact on industry, impact on others from professional experience, leadership exhibited in profession, professional organization membership and roles, and service to others as demonstrated by the nominator's letter of nomination and letter/(s) of reference.

Guidelines for Nomination:

- Submit the completed nomination form.
- Attach one to three additional letters of reference. Names, addresses and an email must be included on reference letters.
- Attach candidate's professional document(s) - resumes preferred, CVs accepted.
- Award of Merit winners are not eligible for this award.
- All nomination forms, resumes, and letters of recommendation must be completed and submitted electronically to acesalumni@illinois.edu.
- **Nomination forms are due September 26, 2025.**

Candidates will be considered for one year. Nominators can resubmit an updated nomination for two subsequent years. If a nominee is not selected within a three-year period, the candidate can be re-nominated after three additional years.
